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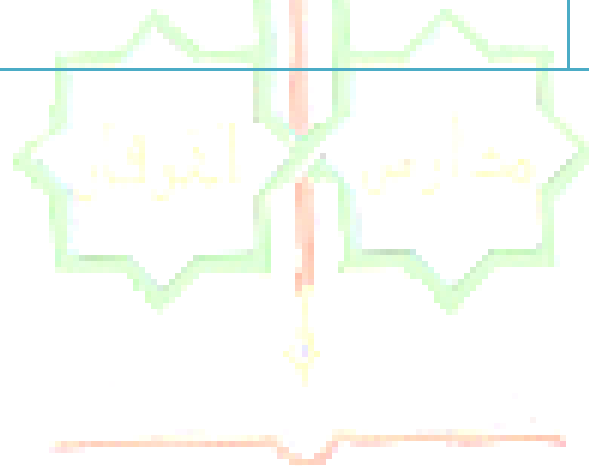

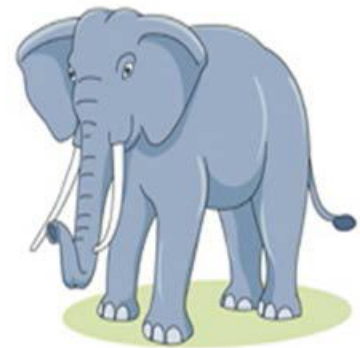

A male, African elephant can weigh up to six thousand kilos. Elephants can be up to four meters tall. Elephants need to live in very large areas because they eat and drink so much.

Every day, elephants spend about 16 hours eating. They eat up to 200 kilos of food. They can drink over 250 liters of water. Elephants are mammals, so a female elephant gives birth of one **calf** after 22 months. Elephants have very big, very thin ears. Elephants use their ears to cool themselves down.

An elephant's trunk can smell food, water, and predators. Elephants need very strong legs to support their heavy bodies. Elephant tusks are really long, curved teeth. Elephants use their tusks to dig for food and water and to fight.
