Staying safe in a car is super **important**. Here are some easy ways to make sure you're safe every time you hop in a car.

Firstly, always wear your seatbelt to keep you safe if something unexpected happens, like if the car stops suddenly or gets into a crash. Click it before you start moving and ask everyone else in the car to do the same.

Next, sit properly. That means sitting straight and keeping your back against the seat. Don't lean out the window or sit with your legs up, as it can be dangerous if the car suddenly stops.

Another thing to remember is to listen to the driver. They have the important job of making sure everyone gets to where they're going safely. Don't distract them by shouting or playing loudly.

Always follow the rules of the road. Stop at red lights and stop signs and listen when the driver says to be careful. It's essential to be patient and wait for your turn.

Never play with things in the car that could distract the driver, like the radio or buttons. It's important to keep the driver focused so they can concentrate on driving safely.
