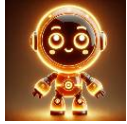

Elephants can live up to 70 years. They use their trunks for drinking water, bathing and eating. They can also communicate over a distance using sounds that people cannot hear. Elephants keep moving their huge ears to cool themselves. Elephants' feet are large, round and very strong so people train them to carry heavy things. In the past, elephants were killed in big numbers for their tusks. Nowadays, special laws protect them and it is not allowed to hunt them.

(2) There are two types of elephants: the African elephant and the Indian elephant. African elephants have larger ears. The African elephant is **very big**. It grows up to 3 meters tall and weighs more than 5000 kilograms. The Indian elephant is smaller and it has smaller ears. Another name for the Indian elephant is the Asian elephant. Sometimes, elephants can destroy the crops of a village in one night. It is a real problem for people. There are about 60,000 elephants in Africa.

(3) The greatest threat to elephants is the ivory trade. About 400 wild elephants are killed for ivory every year. What a pity! Hunters can sell ivory items for a huge amount of money. In 1989, the trade in ivory became less, but elephants are still killed for ivory until recently.
