(1) When you plant a seed, does it stay a seed forever? No! Plants and animals grow and change during their lives. Many plants begin as seeds. The seed needs water, sunlight, and food. It gets them from the soil. It begins to grow. The seed becomes a small plant. It keeps growing until it is an adult plant. Then the plant makes new seeds, so that new plants can grow even after the plant grows old and dies.

(2) Animals also have life cycles. Frogs get out from an egg. They grow legs and arms, and finally become adult frogs. The adult frogs lay eggs, so that new frogs can live even after the frog grows old and dies. A dog's life cycle is a little different than a frog's. A baby frog begins as an egg, but a baby dog is born from its mother. The puppy keeps growing and is eventually an adult dog. Then the adult dog might have puppies to continue the life cycle.

(3) Birds go through life cycles, too. Birds begin as eggs. After some weeks, they leave the eggs. Chicks are born blind, featherless, and completely reliant on their parents for food and warmth. Both parent birds take turns feeding and caring for the chicks. They turn into big birds. Then birds lay eggs, so that little birds can live even after the old birds grow old and die.

Understanding life cycles helps us appreciate the wonders of nature and how living organisms grow and change over time.
