Baby whales are called calves and can weigh over 2,000 kilograms at birth. Whales use their blowholes to breathe air and make sounds to communicate with each other over long distances. They also flap their fins and tails to move through the water. In the past, whales were hunted heavily for their blubber and meat, but now there are laws to protect them from hunting.

(2) There are many species of whales, including the blue whale and the humpback whale. Blue whales are the largest and have a long, slender body, while humpback whales are smaller and known for their impressive jumping and singing abilities.
