Artificial Intelligence, or AI, is quickly becoming a part of everyday life. You may not see a robot walking down the street, but AI is already working behind the scenes in your phone, your car, your favourite apps and even in your home. In some countries, like Japan, robots are already working in hospitality jobs like serving food and welcoming people. But what kind of jobs can AI actually do?

AI is very good at jobs that need speed, accuracy and a lot of data. For example, in banking, AI can help to check thousands of transactions in seconds. It can spot mistakes quickly and easily or even catch people trying to commit ***fraud***. Similarly, in medicine, AI can help doctors find problems in X-rays and scans faster than humans can. And in customer service, AI chatbots can answer simple questions all day and all night without getting tired.

Many factories already use AI-powered robots. These robots don't need breaks, and they can do the same task perfectly again and again. For example, in car manufacturing, robots put parts together much faster than humans. In supermarkets, AI systems can help manage stock and even suggest what products to buy next.

Another big area where AI is used is in transport. Self-driving cars and delivery drones use AI to understand traffic, weather and obstacles. Although they still need human supervision, AI helps make travel safer and more efficient despite the few accidents reported




