People prefer shopping in hypermarket because it is convenient, international and one-stop-shopping. Besides, there are special offers that most customers like. In hypermarkets, goods are placed on open shelves. The customers help themselves to choose what they want and put them in the shopping



basket, then take them to the check-out counter. There are usually special shelves in hyper markets for inexpensive items just in front of the check - out counter: such as chocolate, sweets, gum and so on.

When customers reach the check - out counter, they can pay cash or with a bank card. Customers feel glad because their shopping is finished. To give comfort to customers, hypermarkets provide parking areas and stay open until very late at night. Nowadays, many of the hypermarkets become huge shopping centers and malls.

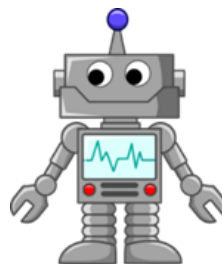
