Adjective order

When you use more than one adjective before a noun, the adjectives go in a certain order.

| Opinion | Size/Shape | Age | Color | Nationality | Material |
|------------------------|--------------|----------------|-------------------|---------------|----------|
| expensive | Large | young | red . | Saudi Arabian | wooden |
| difficult beautiful | round big | ancient old | turquoise blue | British | glass |

<u>Note:</u> Usually, only one to three adjectives are used to modify a noun at a time. E.g.

The beautiful, old, stone house has been put up for sale.

I have two <u>large</u>, <u>brown</u> sofas in my living room.

Too and Enough
