



Subject + Verb (Simple Past)



I *saw* a bear!



I *didn't know* what to do!

(Question Word) *Did* + Subject + Verb (Base Form)

What did you do? *Did* you run away?

Yes, I *did*! / No, I *didn't*!

Past Progressive

Used for long, sometimes interrupted actions in the past.



Subject + *Was/Were* + Verb + *-ing*

They *were hiking* in the forest.

She *wasn't reading* the map.

(Question Word) *Was/Were* + Subject + Verb + *-ing*

Where *were* they going?

Was she *wearing* hiking boots?

Yes, she *was*. / No, she *wasn't*.
