Past Progressive

Used for long, sometimes interrupted actions in the past.



Subject + Verb (Simple Past)

Subject + *Was/Were* + Verb + *-ing*

✓

I *saw* a bear!

They *were hiking* in the forest.

✗

I *didn't know* what to do!

She *wasn't reading* the map.

(Question Word) *Did* + Subject +
Verb (Base Form)

(Question Word) *Was/Were* + Subject +
Verb + *-ing*
