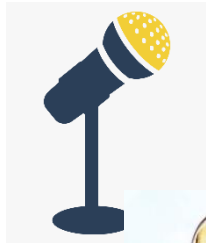

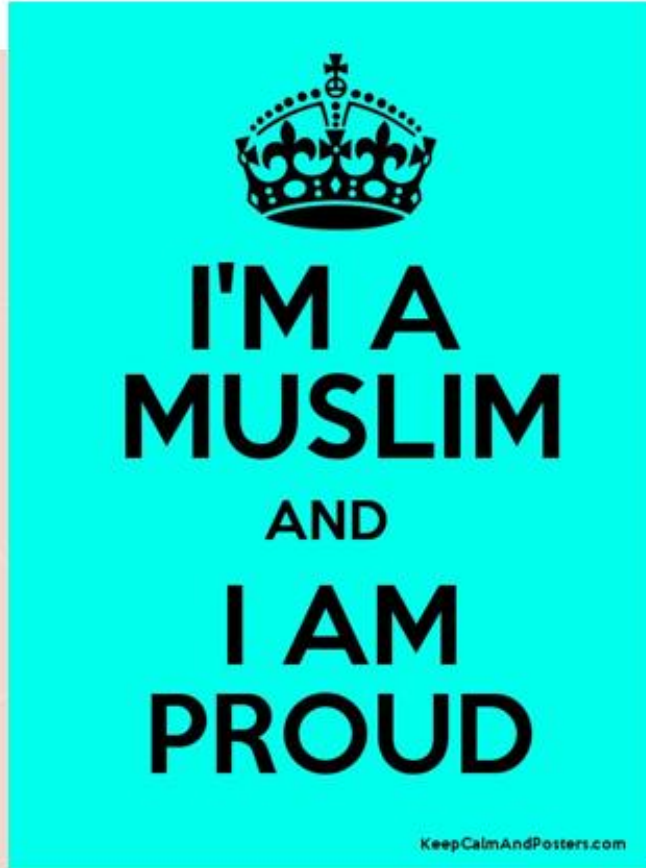

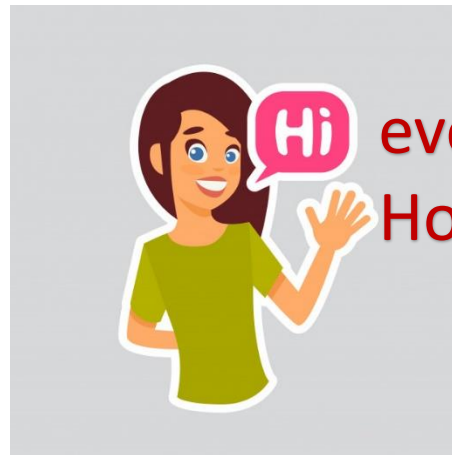

The activities and sports, such as painting and swimming, often use the **-ing** form as a noun. What other activities or sports use the **-ing** form? For examples, cooking, reading, ice skating, cycling, climbing, running, and skiing.

An infinitive is *to* + the base form of a verb. Like gerunds, infinitives act like nouns and answer the question *what*. The verbs *like*, *love*, *hate*, and *prefer* can go with either a gerund or an infinitive.

I like **to watch** TV, but I prefer **to play** games online.

We use infinitives after certain verbs and phrases, such as:

hate	love	want
like	prefer	would like



I **would like** to \_\_\_\_\_.

I **prefer** to \_\_\_\_\_.

I **hate** to \_\_\_\_\_.

some verbs can be followed by either an infinitive or a gerund. The meaning of sentences with these verbs is almost the same.

We can say, for example, I **love** reading books or I **love** to read books.

(One slight difference is that the person is more likely to use the gerund at the moment of doing the activity.)

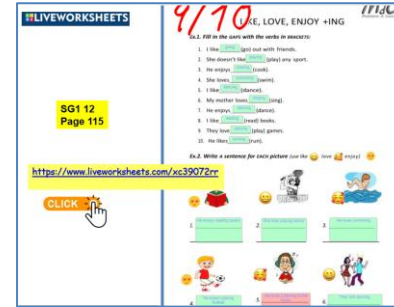
