Present Simple & Present Continuous

Present Simple



S + verb

Express general truths

E.g: It rarely rains in the desert.

Indicate present habits

E.g: The birds return to the island every morning.

Express timetable events

Present Continuous

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S + am/is/are (not) + V-ing

Describe actions happening now

E.g: She is reading a newspaper upstairs.

Express annoying habits (+ always)

E.g: You're always forgetting to pay the bills.

Describe future arrangements

PRESENT SIMPLE VS CONTINUOUS

– MEANING

PRESENT SIMPLE

HABITS. REGULAR OR REPEATED ACTIONS

- I **wash** my hair every day.
- He usually **gets up** very early.

FACTS, PERMANENT SITUATIONS OR STATES

- I **have** one brother. He **lives** in Paris.
- Water **boils** at 100 degrees.

WITH *STATIVE VERBS

- Give me the money. I **need** it now.
- What happened? You **look** sad.

SIGNAL WORDS

always, never, often, sometimes, every day, once a month, twice a week, etc.

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

ACTIONS IN PROGRESS NOW

- I can't talk. I'm **brushing** my teeth.
- He can talk now. He's **having** a shower.

ACTIONS IN PROGRESS AROUND NOW

- I'm **reading** a new book. I love it!
- He **is training** hard these days.

SIGNAL WORDS

now, at the moment, these days, this week, this month, etc.

I DO IT REGULARLY

- I **drink** tea.
- I **do** yoga.

I'M DOING IT NOW

- I'm **drinking** tea.
- I'm **doing** yoga.

***Verbs of the senses:** hear, see, smell, look, seem, sound. **Opinion:** believe, consider, like, love, hate, prefer, think, etc. **Possession:** have, own, belong, etc. **Also:** be, need, mean, remember, want, etc.

Present Simple vs. Present Continuous

Present Simple Tense

1 For facts or things that are always true or generally true.

- ✓ Whales **live** in the ocean.
- ✓ A dog **has** four legs.
- ✓ It **rains** a lot in winter.
- ✓ Water **boils** at 100° Celsius.



Present Simple Tense

2 For regular habits or repeated actions.

- ✓ I **brush** my teeth three times a day.
- ✓ I **read** in bed every night.
- ✓ She **goes** to the gym after work.
- ✓ He **walks** to school every day.



Common time expressions used with the present simple tense are:

- ✓ always, often, generally, sometimes, never ...
- ✓ every day, every week, every year ...
- ✓ once a day, twice a week, three times a month ...
- ✓ in the morning, in the afternoon, at night

✓ I **live** in England.

Present Simple Tense

I plan to live in England for a long time and I don't plan to change soon. It is more or less permanent.



✓ I **am living** in London at the moment.

Present Continuous Tense

The situation is temporary. Next month I plan to live in a different city.

Present Continuous Tense

1 For an action happening right now at the moment of speaking.

- ✓ I **am teaching** an English lesson.
- ✓ You **are watching** a video.
- ✓ Steve **is washing** his hair.
- ✓ She **is taking** her dog for a walk.




Present Continuous Tense

2 To talk about something that is happening AROUND the time of speaking but not necessarily at this exact moment.

✓ I **am reading** a great book.

It doesn't necessarily mean that I am reading a book right at this moment. It refers to this moment of my life.



Common time expressions used with the present continuous tense are:

- ✓ now, right now
- ✓ at the moment
- ✓ still

✓ It **rains** a lot in winter.

Present Simple Tense

This is a fact. It is generally true.



✓ It **is raining** right now.

Present Continuous Tense


This is an action happening now. The situation is temporary. Tomorrow it might be sunny.

Present Progressive

Present Continuous

Actions happening now

- She **is reading** a newspaper upstairs.
- I'm busy, I'm **doing** my homework.

Annoying habits (+ **always**)

- You're **always** forgetting to pay the bills.
- He's **always** singing in the shower.



The progressive is used mainly for two reasons—to express that something is happening right now, or that something happening now is temporary.

The sun shines most days. Today it isn't shining. It's cloudy.
He talks quietly. He is talking to his friend now.
He usually walks to school. Today he is taking the bus.

I close the door every day when I leave.
I am closing the door now.

Simple Present versus Present Progressive

Use the simple present to talk about permanent actions like habits or routines.

Use the present progressive to talk about temporary actions that are happening now.

The students usually **write** tests every month. (habit or routine)

The students **are writing** a test at the moment. (happening now)

TEMPORARY

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
