Eid Ul Fitr Holiday

Eid Ul Fitr is the ninth month of the Hijri is the holy month of Ramadan. This Eid celebration is about sharing what you have with others, including giving Zakat Al Fitr, a special payment to charity. Family and friends tend to gather with the children, who are given *Eidia* gifts. People wear new clothes. Then everybody enjoys a traditional feast of delicacies, such as mugalgal, jareesh and margoog.

Eid Ul Adha Holiday

Eid Al Adha, the Festival of Sacrifice, takes place on the 10th day of the final month of the Islamic calendar, Dhu al-Hijjah. Marking the end of the Hajj pilgrimage to the holy city of [Makkah](#). Today, many Saudi families still sacrifice a sheep — or a goat, cow or even a camel. The meat is divided into three parts and then shared among family, friends and neighbors and people less fortunate.

National Day **September 23rd**

The occasion is marked with fireworks, Saudi flags lining the streets. Special cultural events are held. people decorate their cars and homes to buildings lit up in green for the day.




