Teaching Tip

Just as it is important to teach students how to use a dictionary effectively, they also need to know their way around other sources of information such as encyclopedias and other reference works. Show students how to use the table of contents and the index of an encyclopedia so that they can find the information they need quickly and effectively.



Additional Activity

Tell students to imagine they are tour guides who take visitors through the new port and facilities used for international cargo, or a new gallery or museum. Using the tour guide they listened to on page 21 as a model, have students prepare the text of what they are going to say. They then take their classmates on the tour.
