



can, could, may, and might are modal auxiliaries.

Their form is the same for all persons (I, you, he, she, it, we, they, etc.).

After the modal, we use the main verb in its base form (without *to*).

Can, May, and Could are used to ask for permission. For example, *May I go out to drink some water?* A child might ask a parent: *Can I watch TV after dinner?*

Can and Could are also used to make requests and offers.

Can/May/Could

We use the modal verbs *can, may, and could* to ask for permission.



May/Could are more formal

We use *can and may* to give permission and *can't and may not* to refuse.

Ask for Permission

Can I have another cookie?

May I use your computer?

Could we come with you?

Give Permission

Yes, you **can**.

Yes, you **may**.

Refuse

No, you **can't**.

No, you **may not**.

We also use *can and could* to make requests and offers.

Could you bring me some water?




