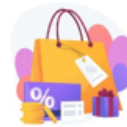

They are العامية when It is not necessary to mention or repeat a noun, either singular or plural.

We use possessive adjectives (*my, your, his, her, our, their*) to indicate that one person or thing belongs to another or is related to another.

11 Form, Meaning and Function



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الجاميها

can, could, may, and might are modal auxiliaries.
Their form is the same for all persons (I, you, he, she, it, we, they, etc.).
After the modal, we use the main verb in its base form (without *to*).

Can, May, and Could are used to ask for permission. For example, *May I go out to drink some water?* A child might ask a parent: *Can I watch TV after dinner?*

Can and *Could* are also used to make requests and offers.

Can/May/Could

We use the modal verbs *can, may, and could* to ask for permission.
We use *can* and *may* to give permission and *can't* and *may not* to refuse.

FYI

May/Could are more formal

Ask for Permission

Can I have another cookie?

May I use your computer?

Could we come with you?

Give Permission

Yes, you **can**.

Yes, you **may**.

Refuse

No, you **can't**.

No, you **may not**.

We also use *can* and *could* to make requests and offers.
