## Adverbs of Manner

Adverbs of manner are formed by adding **-ly** to an adjective. They express how something is done.

Adverbs of manner usually go after the main verb or after the object of the main verb.

adverb (ly)

1 He drives **slowly**.

He is reading the map **carefully**.

2 Adjectives that end in **-l**, double the **l**: careful → carefully adverb (lly)

3 Adjectives that end in consonant **-y**, change **y** to **i**: easy → easily adverb (ily)

Note: Some adjectives and adverbs have the same form:

4 He's a **fast** driver. He drives **fast**.

We ate a **late** dinner. We ate dinner **late**.

He's a **hard** worker. He works **hard**.

The mountain is **high**. They climbed **high**.

adverb ☺ = ☺

Note: The adverb form of **good** is **well** and the comparative form is **better**.
