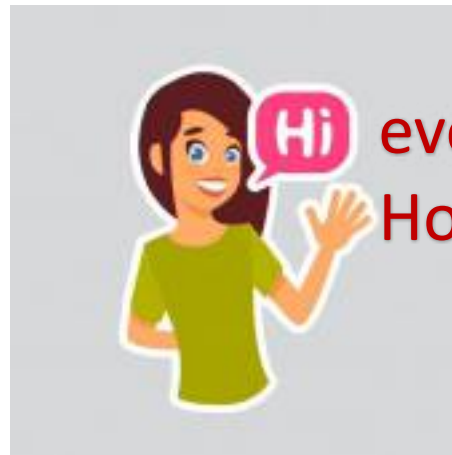

It is not necessary to mention or repeat a noun, either singular or plural.

We use possessive adjectives (*my, your, his, her, our, their*) to indicate that one person or thing belongs to another or is related to another.

possessive adjectives, like regular adjectives, describe the nouns that they precede.
*The possessive adjectives are always followed by a singular or plural noun and that the form of the possessive adjective is always the same, whether it is before a singular noun or a plural noun.

very = a high degree or a large amount

too + adjective ✗ not

✓ The coffee is **too** hot. I can't drink it.

too hot → it is not possible to drink.
too normally has a negative meaning

very + adjective ✓

✓ The fridge is **very** heavy, but Mike can lift it.



very heavy → it is difficult, but possible.

too + adjective ✗ not

✓ The fridge is **too** heavy. Steve can't lift it.

too heavy → it is not possible to lift.
