

**Why do we have speed limits?**

Most roads in most countries have a speed limit. When driving on these roads, drivers must obey the speed limit. In the U.S., the speed limit on most highways is 65 miles (105 kilometers) per hour. In Europe, the speed limit on most highways is a little higher— about 75 miles (120 kilometers) per hour. Generally, speed limits are intended to make driving safer for everyone. People who drive fast are more likely to die in car accidents. Over the past 40 years, lowering the speed limit on highways has lowered the amount of people who have died in car accidents. Some roads also have minimum speed limits. This means that you must not drive slower than the minimum speed. Highways have minimum speed limits because people who drive too slowly can be dangerous when all of the other drivers are moving fast. Speed limits are also made for environmental reasons. Driving slower uses less gas and causes less pollution. But, whatever the reason for the speed limit, no matter what country you are driving in, you must obey the speed limit. If you drive too fast, you will probably have to pay a fine, or a penalty.
