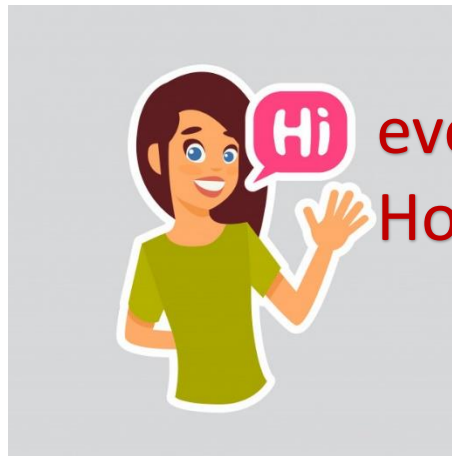

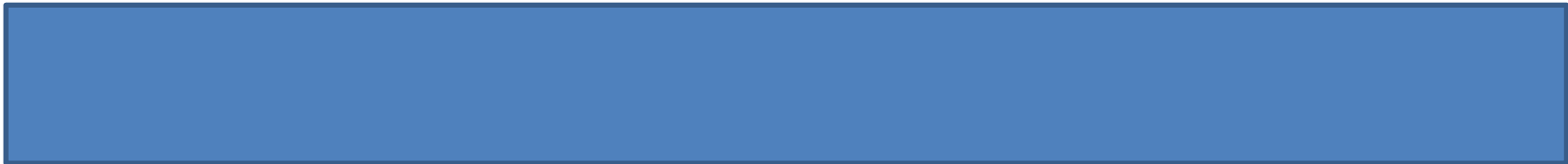

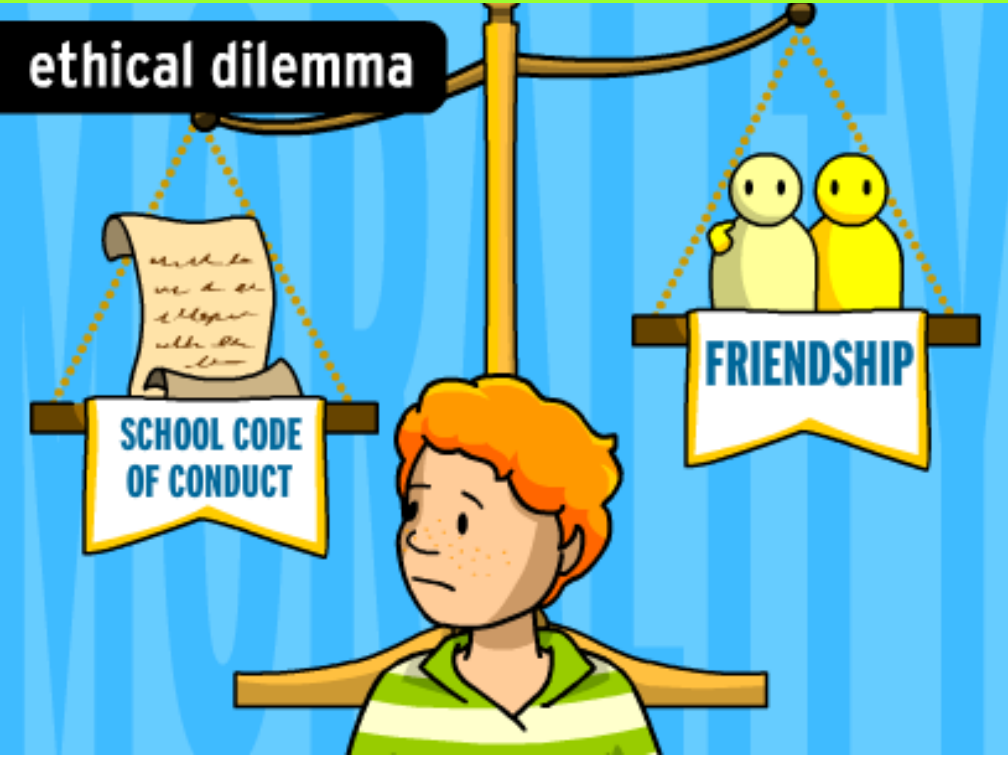

## Teaching Tip
