<b>Advances</b>	to see, find, or become aware of (something) for the first time
<b>Melt</b>	to cause (two or more things) to be together or to work together
<b>Proliferate</b>	a series of actions made to carefully observe their effects in order to learn about something
<b>Discover</b>	to change from a solid to a liquid usually because of heat
<b>Life expectancy</b>	to create or produce (something useful) for the first time
<b>Invent</b>	the state of being created or made more advanced
<b>Breakthrough</b>	careful study that is done to find and report new knowledge about something
<b>Development</b>	to increase in number or amount quickly
<b>Combine</b>	the average number of years that a person or animal can expect to live
<b>Experiment (verb)</b>	an important discovery that happens after trying for a long time to understand or explain something
<b>Research</b>	progress in the development or improvement of something

<b>Analyze</b>	something that can be observed and studied and that typically is unusual or difficult to understand or explain fully
<b>Heal</b>	something (such as a drug or medical treatment) that stops a disease and makes someone healthy again
<b>Phenomenon</b>	something that provides protection against possible loss, or damage.
<b>Discovery</b>	to learn the nature and relationship of the parts of (something) by a close and careful examination
<b>Safeguard (noun)</b>	the work of designing new products or systems by using scientific methods using energy that is created when the nuclei of atoms are split apart or joined together
<b>React</b>	the recent increase in the world's temperature that is believed to be caused by the increase of certain gases
<b>Nuclear engineering</b>	the act of finding or learning something for the first time
<b>Cure (noun)</b>	to behave or change in a particular way when something happens, is said
<b>Global warming</b>	to make (someone or something) healthy or well again

**Timesaving**

a science that deals with things that are alive at the level of the smallest possible amount of a particular substance that has all the characteristics of that substance

**Genetic engineering**

the scientific study of how people, animals, and machines control and communicate information

causing something to happen or end faster

**Molecular biology**

to cause (someone or something) to be in a dangerous place or situation

**Vaccine**

the science of making changes to the genes of a plant or animal to produce a desired result

**Cybernetics**

someone who fears or dislikes modern machines (such as computers)

**Innovation**

a substance that is usually injected into a person or animal to protect against a particular disease

a new idea, device, or method
