It's a story about a small-town doctor who finds he's making more money by looking after the local children's pets than he is by looking after humans. Then he gets into trouble with the police, because he doesn't have the right sort of license to do this and, surprise, surprise, the children and their pets find a way to solve his problems. But my advice is, when it comes to a cinema near you stay in and shampoo the cat.
