
grasslands to grow crops and raise farm animals. The wildlife can no longer live there.





Invasive species are also a serious threat to the wildlife of a region. They spread into a natural environment, where they do not belong, by human activity such as tourism and trade. An example of an invasive species is the lionfish. It is a species native to the South – Pacific Ocean and in recent years (from 1991) it has been spotted in the Mediterranean Sea.

1. natural environment	A group of similar organisms that are able to reproduce.
2. biodiversity	The act of using too much of something e.g. overfishing, over hunting.
3. habitat	This is another word for farming. It includes growing crops and raising farm animals.

5. species	This is the illegal hunting, killing or capturing of animals.
6. endangered species	This is created mainly by human activities. It makes Earth dirty and unhealthy. It can be found in the air, the land and the water.
7. extinction	The natural home or environment of an animal where it lives, finds its food, finds a mate, and reproduces.
8. agriculture	This is when a habitat is destroyed and no longer able to support the plants, animals, or other organisms that live in it.
9. overexploitation	This is the variety of the different types of plants and animals that exist in a particular area or in the world generally.
10. overfishing	The Increase of greenhouse gases and global warming affects and changes the Earth's climate system.
11. poaching	The dying out of a species, forever disappearing from the wild.
12. climate change	Humans catch so many fish that the species cannot grow back, it decreases in numbers until it becomes extinct.
13. global warming	A species, which is not extinct, but it is in danger of becoming extinct.
14. pollution	This means meeting the needs of our generation in a way that allows the future generations to meet their needs, too.
15. sustainability	This is caused by human activities which make the Earth hotter and hotter.
