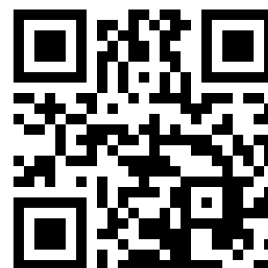

Lawyer most popular career choice for Georgetown teens

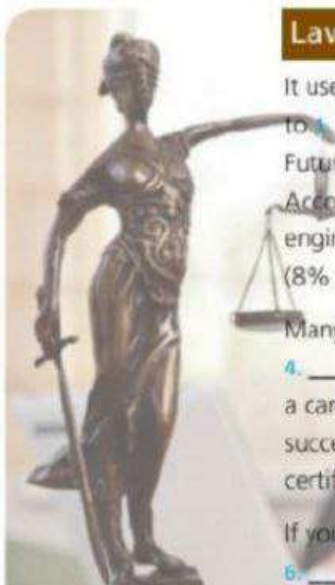
